

Does your child have tics?

Do you have a child, **ages 13-18**, who makes uncontrollable movements or sounds called “tics”?

If so, you and your child may be eligible to participate in **Project BBIT**, a research study examining brain-behavior interactions in tics. The study involves 3 visits. Study activities include an assessment, a brain scan, brief stimulation of the brain using a hand-sized magnet, and observation of your child’s tics.

Compensation for time and parking will be provided. You will also receive a picture of your child’s brain, a written report of feedback, and referrals if needed.
